

Tiny Tots Curriculum

Tiny Tots is children's first experience of the outside world. This is the first time the children are spending so much time outside their home. Our aim is to provide the children with an environment that is conducive to their optimum development. At this stage the children will not be introduced to formal learning. They will learn through play.

Children acquire social skills by interacting with other children and adults. They learn to share, take turns and co-operate. The free play in various centers provides this opportunity.

Children will be provided a safe environment to challenge them physically. This helps in developing their gross motor skills. Interaction with the outdoor playground equipment also enhances a child's spatial awareness.

Gross motor skills development is encouraged by sensorial and creative play. We provide a combination of Montessori and conventional learning aids.

Exposure to Language, Pre Mathematical concepts, Creative Expression and early experience in Science is provided through Thematic Topics.
